“Missing Girl Found By Ironbound Ambulance EMTs”

On October 23rd, 2012, at 5:07 PM, Ironbound Ambulance EMTs responded to Newark Penn Station after receiving a 911 call of a 56 year old man suffering from chest pain and a headache. When EMS arrived on the scene, the man was accompanied by a 45 year old woman and 6 year old child.

While in transport to Saint Michael’s Medical Center, EMTs Cristiana Oliveira and Bruno Castanheira noticed that “something was wrong.” The patient seemed “nervous and uneasy,” and claimed that he did not want anyone to know where he was being treated.

Upon arrival to Saint Michael’s Emergency Room, EMT Oliveria began gathering information from the 45 year old woman and 6 year child. Oliveria quickly noticed discrepancies in both the woman and child’s stories and contacted the New Jersey Transit Police to begin an investigation. It was concluded that the child was abducted earlier that afternoon from the Bronx, NY. She was shortly thereafter reunited with her parents.
